- Assist in the hands-on installation, maintenance, and/or remediation of green roof projects, incl. planting, weeding, irrigation installation/adjustment, and related work on extensive/intensive green roof systems, planters, meadows, and interiorscapes, as required, applicable, and appropriate based on project needs.
- Carry out standard horticultural practices, including but not limited to weeding, planting, pruning, fertilizing, and controlling pests/diseases.
- Provide support to the Horticulture Director and leadership/direction to horticulture team members during site maintenance visits and planting days when Director is not present.
- Provide general assistance to Project Managers, Site Supervisors, and crew, both on and offsite.
- Interface with clients to clearly communicate maintenance tasks and protocols.
- Help maintain a clean and safe work environment on job sites, in the office/shop, and in Recover vehicles.
- Off-site work may include plant sourcing and material pick-ups from local and wholesale nurseries.
- Administrative work may include writing maintenance reports, collecting material prices for new build projects, preparing estimates and proposals, training horticulture crew, and researching/providing plant recommendations for new green roof projects.

The Horticulture Specialist is expected to complete tasks efficiently while following best safety practices and meeting our quality standards.

## **Minimum Qualifications**

- <u>Horticultural</u> -Must have at least **2 years** of hands-on experience in horticulture or landscaping, specifically working with perennials, trees, shrubs, and tropical indoor plants.
- Degree in Horticulture, Environmental Science, Forestry, Agroecology, Landscape Design, etc. a plus.
- Experience working with New England's plant palettes and environments.
- Knowledge of plant pathology and organic pest management.
- Knowledge of plant growth habits, overwintering practices, soil/water/feeding needs, etc.
- Irrigation Hands-on experience with automated irrigation systems, incl. drip and sprinkler irrigation.
- Must be comfortable using or learning to use Excel, Google Sheets, and/or other technological platforms.
- Must be reliable with a strong ability to both take direction and work independently.
- Must have excellent powers of communication and critical thinking skills.
- Must have an innate attention-to-detail and the ability to self-pace.
- Must have good references that can attest to your work ethic.
- Valid driver's license with comfort driving and parking in Boston.
